FENS EJM Young Investigator Prize

It is a personal prize of GBP 7,000. Candidates must either be of European origin if working outside of Europe. Individuals must be neuroscientists.

FENS EJM Young Investigator Prize 2018

This biennial prize sponsored by Wiley, publishers of EJM, will be awarded in recognition of outstanding scientific work in any area of neuroscience.

Personal Prize £ 7 000

Requirements

Candidates must either be working in a European research institution or be of European origin, if working outside of Europe. Individuals may apply themselves or be nominated by a fellow neuroscientist.

- Age limit is 35 years (at the nomination deadline) with variations related to maternity/paternity career breaks as below*
- Award will be presented at the FENS Forum 2018 in Berlin (July 2018).
- Awardee will be required to give a Special Lecture at the FENS Forum and to write a review article for publication in EJM.

*FENS and EJM are committed to secure equal terms for individuals from all countries without family. The following age rule apply for the Young Investigator Prize.

Women: 18 months per child is added to the age limit of 35 years

Men: actual time of paternity leave is added to the age limit 35 years

Application should include the following information:

- Short CV
- A one page statement of research interests and achievement date
- A list of up to 10 publications, including pdf versions of the prominent articles by the applicant
- A short summary of current research
- Names and e-mail addresses of two key scientists in the field to provide a letter of recommendation on request

Evaluation

Applications will be evaluated by a Committee formed by members of the FENS Executive Committee and the co-Editors in Chief of E

The evaluation committee will meet in March 2017 and the recipient of the prize will be notified by 1 April 2017.

Timeline for application: 5 January - 13 February 2017
